- I. Priority use of Library computers and databases is for research activities of Minnesota State University, Mankato students, faculty and staff. Computers are available for use by general public to pursue academic matters.
- II. The Library is a public building. Library patrons should be aware that websites may contain offensive material. Library patrons are expected to show consideration for others as to what is appropriate for display in a public area.
- III. Reproductions (e.g. print, digital, audio, etc.) made by users of Library Services' electronic resources are governed by the Fair Use Section (Title 17, Section 107) of the U.S. Copyright Law¹ as well as by vendor license agreements.
- IV. Use of all computers in the Library as well as use of the Library network is subject to all applicable MSU student², MSU employee², and MnSCU policies³, for use of information technology resources.
- V. Violators of this policy are subject to all allocable MSU student², MSU employee², and MnSCU policies³, sanctions and/or local, state⁴, and federal laws.
